From Nirvana to other states of mind

"Nirvana: Taking Punk to the Masses": What Liverpool is to the British Invasion or Detroit to Motown, Seattle is to grunge. So it's only fitting that the most extensive exhibition on Nirvana, the genre's most important band, should be mounted there, at the Experience Music Project. The show includes more than 200 items, ranging from fans' oral history accounts to a sweater worn by the band's late singer-songwriter-guitarist, Kurt Cobain. Other objects include guitars, a painting Cobain did in high school, a reel-to-reel tape machine owned by his aunt, handwritten lyrics to several of the band's songs, and numerous candid photographs from Nirvana's early years. *325 5th Ave. North, 877-367-7361, www.emp.museum.org*

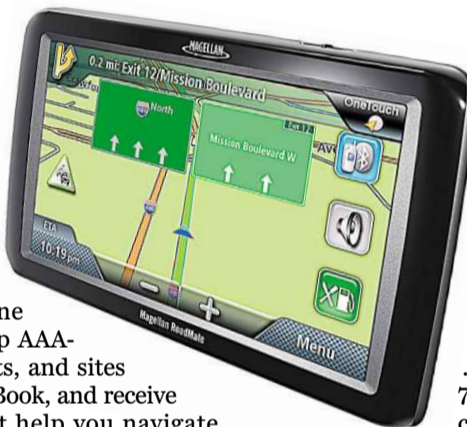

Integrated data keeps you on the right track

Magellan's RoadMate 9055-LM global positioning system is a luxury data center for your car's dashboard. You can read text and maps at a glance on the 7-inch widescreen LCD, sync the device with your Bluetooth-compatible phone and talk hands-free, look up AAA-approved hotels, restaurants, and sites using the built-in AAA TourBook, and receive real-time traffic alerts that help you navigate around roadway congestion and accidents (no sub-

scription necessary). Update maps of the United States, Canada, and Puerto Rico for the device's lifetime.

The GPS is slim enough to fit into a briefcase or travel bag, but consider buying a travel pouch and clear, plastic screen protector (not included) before you hit the road. It sells for \$279.99 at Best Buy (888-237-8289, www.bestbuy.com), or contact Magellan (800-707-9971, www.magellangps.com).
